Medical Room - Home Guide

The Medical Room is only open at break and lunch times

Please be aware that this a First Aid Room and NOT a substitute for your GP, we are unable to make any diagnosis.



If a student needs a First Aider then they will need to inform their class teacher who will make a decision as to whether they will call for a first aider or if they are well enough to wait until break time or lunchtime.

For all non-emergencies, the opening times are break and lunch times only. For example:

- Headache
- Stomach ache
- Toothache
- Earache
- · Any other general first aid



Water

Please ensure that your son / daughter carries water in a clear plastic bottle every day. Water fountains are provided for them to re-fill during break and lunchtime.





Sanitary

The school does have a supply of pads and tampons; these are for emergencies only, please ensure that girls are carrying their own supplies.

Medication

Your son / daughter must not carry any form of medication on their person during the school day. Excluding an Asthma Pump. Please see the managing medicines policy for further information.



All medical appointments during the school day will require a note beforehand from their parent/carers. This must be shown to your child's Progress Leader during Am registration. All students must sign out at receptionist when leaving. If they return to school the same day, you must sign back in at Reception. Students must not contact their parents/carers via their mobile phone during school hours should they feel unwell, in the first instance they must speak to a member of staff. Failure to follow this policy will result in a C3 being issued.
