## A Guide to Year ten lessons in ICC from 22 ${ }^{\text {nd }}$ June 2020 until $\mathbf{1 7}^{\text {th }}$ July 2020

Each year ten student will attend school one day per week from $22^{\text {nd }}$ June until the end of term. No one who feels unwell or who has someone in their household with any symptoms of covid-19 should come into school. Anyone who feels unwell in school will be sent home to recover.

On each day of the week, three groups of no more than twelve students will be scheduled to come to school. They have been allocated groups called $X, Y$ and $Z$. So there are, in all, fifteen groups. Mon X, Mon Y, Mon Z, Tues X, Tues Y etc. The groups are broadly based on Maths sets.

There are three separate corridors in which the lessons will take place, each with a dedicated set of toilets and staircase.

X groups (Mon X, Tues X etc) will be in S01 for lessons and use the English corridor and MFL toilets. Students are to access these from the back stairs by Reprographics.

Y groups will use F10, the Maths corridor and the toilets beside them. Students are to access these from the front stairs by Reception.

Z group will be in F19 and use the Humanities corridor and the toilets located there. Students are to access these from the central stairs.

Please ensure your child walks, cycles or is given a lift to school.
They should arrive by 8.40, go to the group room (S01 for $\mathrm{X}, \mathrm{F} 10$ for Y and F 19 for Z ) using the staircase for their group ( X - back stairs, Y - Front stairs, Z - central stairs).

In their room they have a seat allocated to them where they need to sit for all three lessons. They are all 2 m apart from each other. On entry to the room they should clean their hands at the sanitizer station.

They will have three, one hour lessons of English, Maths and Science. The three teachers - Mr Weetman, Mr Forsyth and Ms Sumpter will teach a group each on rotation. There are only three teachers used to minimize the exposure of students and teachers to each other.

At each of the lesson changeovers there will be a short break in the dedicated corridor, supervised by SLT, and students should clean their hands before re-entry to the room.

At the end of the three lessons students should go home. The rooms and toilets will be thoroughly cleaned every day.

Students should attend school with their own equipment and in uniform (blazers are optional but no garment should be worn instead of a blazer such as a jumper or hoodie). They will be issued with new books which they should bring to and from school so they would benefit from bringing a bag.

BFL will be used. Any student who reaches C 4 will be sent home.

There will be a few Y12 lessons in the building separated from year ten and the child care group will be moved and based in the PE hub so will not come in the main building. Any year ten student who attends child care cannot attend the lessons.
