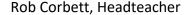
Key aspects that apply to all students are:

- You should walk or cycle to school and avoid public transport wherever possible
- You will be with your year group and should not mix with those in other year groups
- You have an allocated entrance, stairway, toilets and social spaces you must remain in and you will be taught in a limited number of classrooms
- All rooms allocated to a year group will be signposted with their tie colour
- You should sanitize your hands on entry to school and on entry to all classrooms
- Uniform is as normal please wear the correct colour tie
- You should bring in your own equipment
- PE and dance require only trainers
- Free school meals will be provided otherwise you should bring a packed lunch
- Lockers will not be able to be used, unfortunately

The presentations give much more detail and I would urge you to watch them with your child. Please get in touch with us if you have queries about this.

School is to resume on Friday 4th September at 08:15am for Year 7. We ask that your child brings their trainers in on the first day. We also ask, that as well as pack lunches, your child has a healthy snack/drink for their break. As we promote healthy eating at ICC sugar snacks/drinks, sweets and crisps are not permitted in school.
