Re: Year six transition to ICC

Firstly, welcome. We are delighted your child will be transferring to ICC in September. This is an uncertain time and we want to give you one certainty - we will give your child a warm welcome and do all we can to reassure them.

This is an unusual year. We normally have a programme of induction activities in our school that allow our new students to experience school, visit their classrooms and meet their teachers. Sadly, the government guidance for schools will not allow us to do that this year, for very good reasons to keep your child and family safe.

We are looking at ways to effect transition differently. We hope to provide a tour of the school virtually and get welcome greetings from key staff who will support your child.
