SAFEGUARDING IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY

If staff have any concerns about a child's welfare, they must act on them immediately

Worries and concerns need to be reported in person to a member of the **SAFEGUARDING TEAM.** If you need a member of the safeguarding team to come to you please call reception on 2000.

All worries and concerns must then be recorded on CPOMS under the name of the student that the concern is about.

- How it is affecting the student
- What have they disclosed?

Remember to use their words

• Do they have an injury? Give a full description of the injury, where it is on the body, size & colour.

Anything else you know about the student
