If you need to contact the Child Protection Team to make a referral you should phone one of the below numbers.

- When you make a child protection referral and you will be asked for the name and the address of the young person
- A duty Social Worker on a childcare help desk in the relevant Social and Caring Service office will take the details
- You can ask how this will be followed up and ask for progress to be communicated to either yourself or an appropriate school contact
