Level 3 Qualification in Sports Leadership (SL3)



Entry Requirements

Studied PE/Sport qualification at KS4 or experience in Sports Activity Clubs and Grade 4 in GCSE English Language or GCSE English Literature

Course Overview

Young people undertaking a qualification in Sports Leadership will learn and demonstrate important life skills such as effective communication, planning, responsibility and organisation whilst learning to lead basic physical activities to their peers and younger people within the community.

Sessions use sport to deliver fun and engaging physical activities with peers and the community. Students will plan, lead and evaluate sports/physical activity sessions over a number of tutored hours and then demonstrate their leadership skills as part of their assessment. Lessons consist of both guided & peer-to-peer learning including supervised leadership to ensure that learners have developed the skills they need to lead basic physical activities to other people.

Each unit will be assessed individually, through a mixture of written material, practical observations and evidence of planning. All units are submitted towards a final grade of Pass or Fail.
