Level 2 merit in Cambridge National Certificate in ICT (or equivalent)

Qualification Gained

On successful completion of this course you will gain the “Cambridge Technical Level 3 Introductory Diploma in IT ” which is a qualification recognised by many universities alongside A Levels.

Each unit is graded Pass, Merit and Distinction which combine to give an overall grade.

Career Opportunities

The skills and knowledge gained on the course will lead to a variety of jobs/careers in the world of IT including Junior Web Application Developer, Junior Application Developer, Junior Software Analyst, Technical support, digital technologies, application development or data analysis.

There is also the opportunity to progress onto a Level 4 apprenticeship such as Network Engineer or Software Developer. The opportunities that this course provides is endless.
