




# How children across West Sussex schools are being disadvantaged

The current picture...

Average per pupil funding



This means that children in West Sussex receive £41 million less than the average authority and £200 million less than pupils in London.

Costs provided below are indicative.

Teacher/TA salaries can vary according to specific roles, experience and expertise.

All costs are used as a guide only.

## How could the money be spent?

- 100 Teachers (£27K inc on costs)
- 100 Teaching Assistants (£14K inc on costs)
- 100,000 Text Books (£7 each)
- 1,000 Computers (£350 each)
- 1,000 iPads (£319 each)
- 1,000 Classroom Kits (£989 each)
