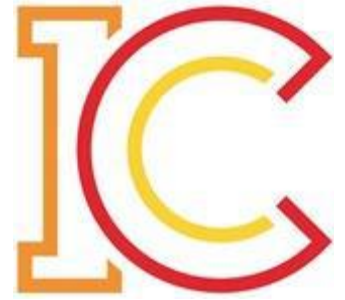




# Job description

- Good at thinking of playground games and willing to learn new ones.

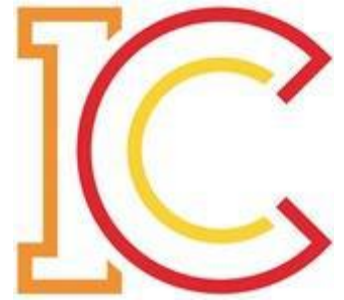
**If you wish to apply:**
