**Re: History Shadow Curriculum for home learning.**

Please see guidance below regarding what students should do if they need to miss any History lessons. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact myself or a member of the History department.

Year 7:

For the first half term, year 7 students will be undertaking a chronological study of entertainment through time analysing the question 'Did the show always go on?' Each lesson will be based on a different time period with a focus on entertainment, ensuring students start their History studies learning key historical skills of chronology and change over time. For students studying at home, an adapted version of the lesson PowerPoint will be provided on Microsoft Teams. The PowerPoint will have all of the information needed, as well as any other necessary resources, with clear tasks to complete. In some cases, there may also be an additional Word document. If students are completing this work from home, they simply need to complete the work on a Word document and upload it to Teams. If you prefer, the PowerPoint can also be downloaded and students can complete the work directly onto this and then upload it to Teams for their teacher to see.

Year 8:

For the first half term, year 8 students will be undertaking a chronological study of ideas over time analysing the question 'Which time period had the best idea?' Each lesson will be based on a different time period with a focus on ideas, ensuring students continue their History studies learning key historical skills of chronology and change over time, as well as enabling them to recap the contextual information they learnt in year 7. For students studying at home, an adapted version of the lesson PowerPoint will be provided on Microsoft Teams. The PowerPoint will have all of the information needed, as well as any other necessary resources, with clear tasks to complete. In some cases, there may also be an additional Word document. If students are completing this work from home, they simply need to complete the work on a Word document and upload it to Teams. If you prefer, the PowerPoint can also be downloaded and students can complete the work directly onto this and then upload it to Teams for their teacher to see.

Year 9:

For the first term, year 9 students will be undertaking a study on the theme of 'Migration'. Students will revisit time periods looked at lower down the school thereby interleaving time periods and building up their historical knowledge and understanding. For students studying at home, an adapted version of the lesson PowerPoint will be provided on Microsoft Teams. The PowerPoint will have all of the information needed, as well as any other necessary resources, with clear tasks to complete. In some cases, there may also be an additional Word document or links to revision websites. If students are completing this



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work from home they simply need to complete the work on a Word document and upload it to Teams. If you prefer, the PowerPoint can also be downloaded and students can complete the work directly onto this and then upload it to Teams for their teacher to see.

#### Year 10:

For the first term, year 10 students will be undertaking the GCSE topic of Early Elizabethan England. For students studying at home, an adapted version of the lesson PowerPoint will be provided on Teams. The PowerPoint will have all of the information needed, as well as any other necessary resources, with clear tasks to complete. In some cases, there may also be an additional Word document or links to revision websites. If students are completing this work from home, they simply need to complete the work on a Word document and upload it to Microsoft Teams. If you prefer, the PowerPoint can also be downloaded and students can complete the work directly onto this and then upload it to Teams for their teacher to see.

#### Year 11:

For the first term, year 11 students will be undertaking the GCSE topic of USA at home and abroad. For students studying at home, an adapted version of the lesson PowerPoint will be provided on Teams. The PowerPoint will have all of the information needed, as well as any other necessary resources, with clear tasks to complete. In some cases, there may also be an additional Word document or links to revision websites. If students are completing this work from home, they simply need to complete the work on a Word document and upload it to Teams. If you prefer, the PowerPoint can also be downloaded and students can complete the work directly onto this and then upload it to Teams for their teacher to see.
