Re: Mathematics shadow curriculum for home learning

I would like to take this opportunity to inform you of the home learning arrangements for Mathematics and highlight the support that is available to students in the event that they are unable to attend school.

Microsoft TEAMS

All work and support is available on Microsoft TEAMS, which students log by going onto their 365 account. This is in the format of the termly overview and the work is designed to cover exactly the work they would do if they are in school. Topics are sequenced in an order to aid progression.

Students should use the document on TEAMS and specifically the Hegarty clip numbers in the document to complete the tasks they would be missing. Students should be able to identify which topic they are in and follow on as appropriate. The website for Hegarty is: www.hegartymaths.com

Support

If students are stuck or not sure how to complete the tasks, there are various ways they can get support. On Hegarty there are support videos for each task that takes students through each topic step by step. If students require help during a task there is a button which says 'get help' that takes them straight to the exact point in the video and will go through the question step by step.

If students are still struggling there are additional online lessons that have been hyperlinked on the termly overview document in TEAMS.

Year 11 students have all been given a FREE revision guide and workbook and should be using this to help them complete the tasks.

Further to this, some students may find they need individual support to fully understand some topics. In the first instance, they should seek assistance from their subject teacher via TEAMS who will be happy to help them.
