







## Books to Read if you Love Diary of a Wimpy Kid

The Diary of a Wimpy Kid series is one of the most popular range of books that is checked out of the school library. We have therefore put together a list of books that are similar and would highly recommend.




Documenting the world of Norm as he moves to a new house and deals with many laugh out loud moments.



